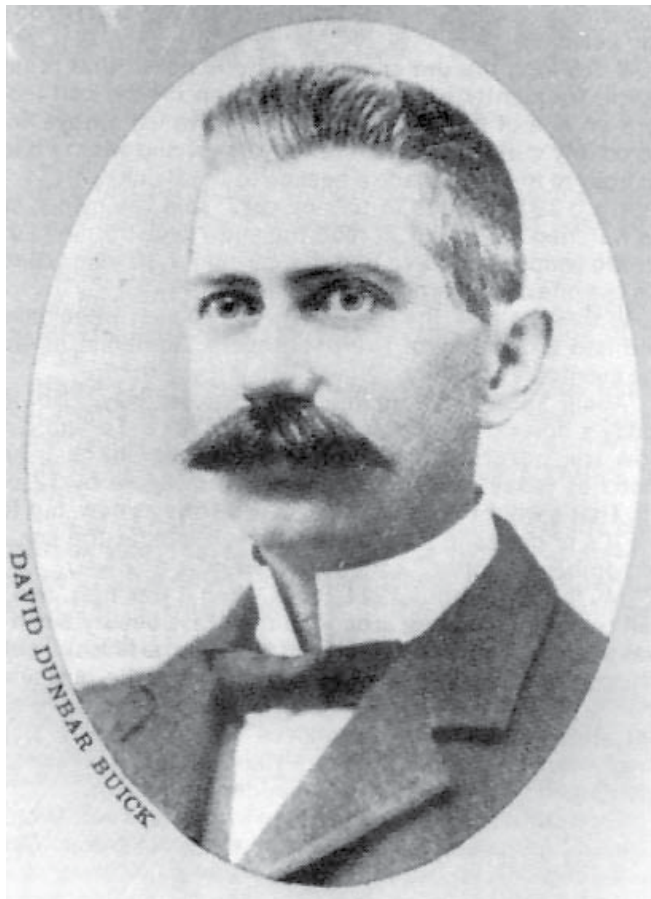




THE HORN



David Dunbar Buick

1854 – 1929

Inventor and engineer. Born in Scotland, he is credited with developing a method for bonding enamel to iron, for the production of baths and sinks. However his passion was the internal combustion engine and the motor-car. In 1903, David started the company that grew into the General Motors Corporation of America, the mightiest car-making empire in the world. Over 17,000,000 cars bearing his name and crest have rolled off production lines, yet he was involved in making only 120 of them.

Resolution Designating July 8, 2011

Collector Car Appreciation Day Introduced in U.S. Senate

At the request of SEMA Action Network (SAN), Senator John Tester (D-MT) and Senator Richard Burr (R-NC) have introduced Senate Resolution 115 (S. Res 115) in the United States Senate, officially designating July 8, 2011 as "Collector Car Appreciation Day." The date marks the second commemoration in an annual event to raise awareness of the vital role automotive restoration and collection plays in American society. The resolution states that the Senate "recognizes that the collection and restoration of historic and classic cars is an important part of preserving the technological achievements and cultural heritage of the United States."
