# February Minutes

Chapter director Steve Hunkins called the meeting to order. He thanked Jeff Morris and All-a –Cart for hosting the meeting and providing dinner. He invited Jeff to give an over view and the activities at All-A-Cart (which will be featured in a subsequent article).

Bill Griffin delivered the treasurer's report. There was \$140 incoming for the month and no expenses. Regarding the great lakes regional, there was \$674 incoming, adding to our registration balance of \$2569 for a grand total of \$4151.32.

Leading to the regional meet, Mike Book noted that we expect 150–200 cars. Steve requested that we have our next meeting at the host hotel and there may be the need for a Saturday meeting when the weather gets warmer to get familiar with the layout for the show.

It was noted that a list of area restaurants should be provided to show attendees. Once this list is collected, it will be posted on our web site.

Presently there are 20 cars and 10 families registered. We need to build up our cash reserve so members are encouraged to register and send in your fees as soon as possible. Once we receive registrations, a confirmation letter with a photocopy of the registration form attached will be sent return mail. This is to insure there are no registration discrepancies at the show.

The trophies have been selected for the regional. We will begin advertising our printing sponsor in the Horn as soon as we receive artwork. Judges from the Arthritis Foundation have agreed to assist in the judging of our show.

Mike Book will prepare a donation letter for sponsors and goodie bag items. Once complete, members are encouraged to use this to solicit donations. Mike will also check on porta johns and will inquire with Kroger about trash barrels.
